
eScript One InQuiry Search by TID and Receipt, View Info from Workflow Folder, Updated Web-browser Tab Names Release Notes

DeliverHealth is pleased to announce the release of updates to InQuery, including additional search fields added to Advanced Search in Search All – Basic Search, a link to open Transcription Info from the Actions column, updated web-browser tab names, and minor bug fixes.

Basic Search - Advanced Search window

- Transcription ID and Receipt Code have been added as new search parameters in the Advanced Search window of Search All – Basic Search.
- The Dates field has been renamed to Date Dictated for more clarification. This update has been applied to all Advanced Search windows across the platform.



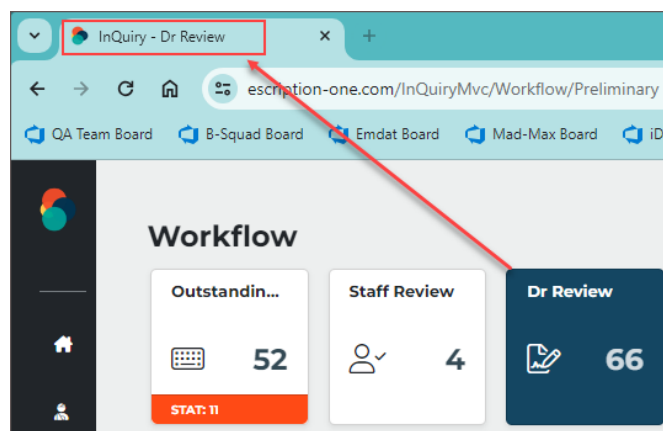
